**SUBJECT: DECLARATION OF EFFECTIVENESS –
RESOLUTIONS 600f, 600g, 600h, 601, 607, 660, 670, and 683
RECOMMENDED PRACTICES 1650, 1675, and 1676**

Kindly refer to Finally Adopted Resolutions (FARs) circulated under memorandum CSC/32/Meet/007/2010 dated 16 April 2010 for new CSC Recommended Practices 1675 and 1676, and amendments to CSC Resolutions 600f, 600g, 600h, 601, 607, 660, 670, 683, and Recommended Practice 1650, adopted at the 32nd meeting of the Cargo Services Conference (CSC/32) held in Vancouver, Canada on 10 March 2010.

Please be informed that all the resolutions and recommended practices included in the above-mentioned FARs were approved and granted antitrust immunity by the United States Department of Transportation (DoT). In addition, IATA Secretariat was not advised of any government actions by the end of the filing period (15 June 2010).

Therefore, we hereby declare the new CSC Recommended Practices 1675 and 1676, and the amendments to CSC Resolutions 600f, 600g, 600h, 601, 607, 660, 670, 683, and Recommended Practice 1650 effective on **1 July 2010**.

This Declaration of Effectiveness will be reflected in the 31st edition of the Cargo Services Conference Resolutions Manual, effective on 1 October 2010.
